1938 – Madge Cluxton purchased US born Trusca of Glenwild (Duke of Moscow X Malora's Diana) born on May 10, 1938, bred by Ernest V. Vettel of Caledonia, North Dakota.

1939 – Bred a litter born on August 8, 1939 (Pojar of Glenwild X Silvia of Glenwild) that produced Prince Boris of Glenwild III.

1939 – Mrs. Cluxton moved from Chicago to Guelph, ON in September, to live with her mother who was a longtime Guelph resident, Mrs. Charles (Miriam) McGill.

1941 – Showed Boris Prince of Glenwild; and also Prince Peterhoff of Glenwild, a US import (Borisovitch of Glenwild X Czarina Prechistenka) later sold to Mme. F. Taranti who showed him at Montreal.

Showed Trusca of Glenwild at Hamilton, a US import.

1942 – Mrs. Cluxton showed Ch. Radziwell Valdai of Glenwild, a really outstanding Borzoi bred by Mrs. H. Kedney of Toronto. He won six Group 1sts and a BIS at the London show. He went on as a group-winning Borzoi in the States as well.

If a person was asked to select a kennel over the last 20 years that has constantly maintained a superior type and quality, the chances are high that the Glenwild Borzoi Kennel would be at the top of the list. The record established by this kennel is something the owner, Mrs.

Madge Cluxton, is very proud of. Glenwild Borzoi have also won more than their share of C.D. and C.D.X. titles.

Showed Czarina of Glenwild at Montreal and Ougar of Glenwild at Caledon.

1942 - Bred a litter born on August 4, 1942 (Radziwell Valdai of Glenwild X Czarina II of Glenwild) that produced Mia of Glenwild kept by Cluxton; Princess Tanya of Glenwild who went to Mrs. M. Andrews who showed her in Halifax in 1943; Miss Timoshenko of Glenwild who went to E. C. Biesel in the US; Diane of Glenwild; Mia of Glenwild; Sandra of Glenwild who went to Kenneth Gemmel of Guelph and Lada of Glenwild who went to Donald & Mrs. Ross of Guelph.
