1915 – There were no dog shows put on during the time period of 1915 to 1924 in Edmonton, and Calgary held shows from 1905 up till 1926.

1916 – A special meeting of the Capital City Kennel Club in Edmonton was held on May 2, 1916, in Dr. C. J. Reid's dental office in the Hart Block on Jasper Avenue. Dr. Reid, who owns and shows Russian Wolf-

hounds, was helping to arrange to send a carload of dogs to the Winnipeg Dog Show, which was being held under CKC rules, on May 16 - 18. All dog fanciers were cordially invited to attend.

1917 – March 17 – At the Brandon, MB dog show there was a strong class of Russian Wolfhounds. The winning puppy bitch was Bonita, with 2nd going to Lady of Sitka and 3rd to Zorva of Arkansas Valley. In dogs, novice was won by Tippy Dondigo followed by Prince of Galitzen. Limit dog: 1st was Jellicoe Rex, 2nd to Kolah of Roseau. Brace class was Thelma and Kolah. Winners dog was Jellicoe Rex and winners bitch was Thelma of Roseau.

1920 – In a comment regarding the Toronto dog show, it was said that there were some capital and well-reared Russian Wolfhounds entered, bred by Mrs. J. Paterson. Some of the other exhibits, although possessing great quality and the approved Roman face, lacked the
