Felice's pedigree shows all English certificate winners for three generations back, and her sire, Graiph of Haywra, by Ripley Perfection, leaves nothing to be desired.

1927 – Purchased from T. R. Lyons, Zola Lyons (Nasskok of Vaski X Olga Ivanoff) born on July 6, 1926, bred by Chester Hobbs of Ontario.

Zola Lyons, when on the block, was like a product of a master sculptor. She has twice won winners, once reserve winners, and also best sporting bitch in show. And these wins were made when she was still under 14 months of age.

1927, August 26 – Zwicker's latest UK importation from Mr. H. Thomson of England was Nona of Shay (Ripley Perfection X Olga of Haywra) born on June 22, 1923, a white bitch with red/brown markings, and will bear close scrutiny, with a pleasing head, excelling in body and coat, nice eye, and standing on good legs and feet. This marvellous bitch is really "the goods". She is an international winner of repute, with a long list of splendid wins to her credit. She was the dam of the last year's two sensations – Winslet of Shay and Korsakoff of Shay – the latter winning at Manchester, special for best Borzoi, with over a score of specials for best head and best bone.

Ch. Korol, (Int. Ch. Johnston's Krilenko X Petrova of Tolstoi), stood 34 inches at the shoulder, head 12 inches and weighed 90 pounds. In two years of showing, this dog was never defeated by any other Russian Wolfhound. Korol won the Vaski cup in 1926, an award open to Canadian-bred dogs from coast to coast. He is a proven sire of wonderful puppies that measure up to the Marlboro standard for quality. His fee, to approved matrons, was \$25.

1927 – Bred a litter born on April 28, 1927 (Korol X Felice of Haywra) that produced Valeska of Marlboro; Valecian of Marlboro; Valor of Marlboro; Volga of Marlboro; and Vida of Marlboro.

1927 – Purchased Marlboro of Vaski (Galaroff O'Valley Farm X Princess Orloff) born June 21, 1927, bred by E. M. Burke of Lambeth, ON.

1927 – Bred a litter born on November 24, 1927 (Korol X Felice of Haywra) that produced Turgenoff of Marlboro who went to F. S. McLelland; Tamaroff of Marlboro; and Tamiloff of Marlboro.
